

APPENDIX M DAC BASKETBALL PLAYOFF POLICY [effective for 2008-09]

FINANCIAL POLICY:

I. Ticket Policy:

1. General admission - \$8.00 one; Game - \$11.00 two games.
2. Students with ID's and children - \$3.00 one game; \$4.00 two games.
3. Cheerleaders in uniform – free.
4. One musical group from each school – free (limited to 25).
5. DAC Lifetime passes and passes issued by the Conference are to be honored.
6. No other passes or price reductions allowed.

II. Allowable Expenses (to be paid by host team):

1. Each official is to be paid \$125.00 per game and \$0.55 mileage for one vehicle (unless the officials come from different sites).
2. Per Diem for officials may be allowed with the approval of the Commissioner.
3. \$1.50 per mile for traveling teams by bus and \$0.40 by car or van. (Limit of three).

III. Report:

1. Institutions are to use the form title DAC Playoff Financial Report for each playoff game. This form is to be completed and filed with the Commissioner's Office by March 15. If you have a net income for a game, a check for that amount should accompany the report. Institutions will not be reimbursed for any financial loss on a game.

IV. Game Times:

1. Games played on weekdays will be scheduled at 7:00 for a single game and 5:30 and 7:30 for double headers.
2. Games played on Sundays will be scheduled at 3:00 for single game and 2:00 and 4:00 for double headers.

NATIONAL TOURNEY TEAM REIMBURSEMENT POLICY:

I. Allowable Expenses:

1. Transportation:

- a. If traveling by ground transportation, the mileage allowed for each way follows (mileage is from city to city):

Car or van	\$0.40 per mile (per vehicle)
Bus	\$2.00 per mile

2. Lodging & Meals:

- a. \$600 per day (count the day left but not the day returned).

II. Payment of Claims:

1. When reimbursing institutions for travel expenses, the available resources from the playoffs will be prorated to all schools participating in the NAIA tourney.

III. Claims:

1. The DAC Claim for NAIA Basketball Expenses Reimbursement form is to be used by the teams that represent the DAC at the NAIA tournaments and are to be filed with the Commissioner's office by April 1.
